Hope's Collection of Art and Ceramics and John Campbell and the Lazy Hill Collection



Join us for our annual Elizabeth Stevenson Ives Lecture on Saturday, May 18, 2024. Dr. Steven and Lynn Walker have been restorers, researchers and collectors for over 50 years. Their current c1842 home in Kentucky is on the National Register of Historic Places and the c1833 home in Tasmania, which they restored, is on the Register of the National Estate. Steven holds qualifications in archaeology and ancient history, research, cultural heritage, conservation and a PhD in settler colonial history. Lynn specialized in fine arts and is a consultant in English ceramics. They will speak on Hope's collection of eighteenth and nineteenth centuries' art and ceramics and its connection to John Campbell of Lazy Hill.
